

RATIONALE

Over the years, a successful professional relationship and a close friendship have been established between eminent Romanian cardiologists and colleagues working in Italy. This long-standing collaboration has resulted also in an effective exchange of young Romanian cardiologists between several Romanian Academic Institutions and the Istituto Auxologico Italiano. Romanian cardiologists have joined Auxologico in Milan in order to run multiple research and training projects.

The results of this exchange have been extraordinary, holding mutual benefits for both the home Institution and Auxologico, as well as for the personal careers and professional growth of the Romanian researchers. This scientific collaboration has been recently formalized into a specific agreement between the Carol Davila University of Medicine in Bucharest and University of Milano-Bicocca in Milan to promote and strengthen the academic cooperation between the two Universities.









